SunYat-sen University is one of the leading comprehensive research universities in China, with academic areas in humanities, social sciences, natural sciences, medical sciences and engineering.

It has about 55,000 students studying on four campuses in Guangzhou and Zhuhai, and nearly 14,000 faculty and staff while owning 40 schools, 5 substantial departments and 8 affiliated hospitals.
